What's going on in Oxon Run?



Project Update

Since the close of the public scoping period, the project team has been reviewing community comments while continuing technical studies and coordination among project partners.

Current activities include:

- Reviewing and documenting public comments received during the NEPA public scoping process.
- Preparing the Environmental Assessment (EA), which will evaluate the potential environmental effects of the proposed project.
- Continuing refinement of the stream restoration design and coordination with DC Water regarding sewer infrastructure improvements.
- Advancing the Oxon Run Park Master Plan, including coordination with local agencies to improve trail connections and recreational opportunities throughout the park corridor.
- Developing a community story map featuring interviews with residents and community organizations to celebrate the history and significance of Oxon Run.



The Environmental Assessment will be released for public review later this year, providing another opportunity for the community to review the project and submit comments before decisions are finalized.
